

Village Hall report for Parish Council

The Village Hall continues to be well supported by regular hirers plus one-off bookings, which are usually Children party bookings. A number of Fundraising events throughout the year have also generated additional income for the Village Hall and Playing Field.

In the last year the hall interior has been decorated by the Community Payback team, their Gardening team has also been used to tidy the car park and the playing field. Solar panels were installed on the main roof in December and these are already generating energy.

Further projects include the sanding and revarnishing of the main hall floor which is scheduled for the May bank holiday. In the future we also hope to improve the surface of the car park and replace the single glazed windows and the lights in order to improve the energy efficiency of the village hall.

The playing field continues to be well used not just by local residents but visitors from farther afield, but the Sports Court was not so well supported as in the previous year. The wooden toddler maze has also been replaced by two picnic benches a contribution to the cost of these was received from the Play Space fund.

The Village Hall Management Committee is grateful for the continued support of the Parish Council towards the upkeep and maintenance of the village hall and playing field.
